

Application for EAA Chapter 1158 “Aviation Advancement Scholarship”

Scholarship Objective:

The purpose of this scholarship is to motivate and financially assist a student who intends to pursue education in a field that advances the purposes and objectives of experimental, private, government and/or commercial aviation.

Scholarship Funding:

The scholarship awarded shall be no less than \$1000.

Scholarship Applicability:

The scholarship must be utilized for tuition & fees by a full-time student in the pursuit of:

1. an Associate degree in a certified aviation related field at an accredited technical school, college or university.
2. a Bachelors degree from an accredited college or university in aviation related field as determined by the selection committee.

EAA Chapter 1158 shall pay the awarded funds directly to the intended educational institution on behalf of the selected student.

Scholarship Eligibility:

To be eligible for the scholarship the individual must comply with the following criteria.

1. High school graduate with a “C” or better average
2. Resident of or enrolled as a student in a school within Ozaukee or Washington counties of Wisconsin
3. Twenty five years of age or younger
4. No felony convictions
5. No convictions related to illegal substances or alcohol abuse or distribution
6. Accepted as a full-time student at an accredited educational institution.
7. Be recommended by a member of the staff from which the individual graduated

8. Submit a complete application, on the official form and with requested attachments, to the selection committee by February 1st of the year in which the award is to be made.
9. U.S. Citizen or legal permanent resident.

Scholarship Application:

The applicant shall complete the following official application form with the required personal information and type of degree/training to be pursued. They shall submit this application to:

The application submitted must also include the following items:

1. Essay of 200 or more words about related aviation ambitions
2. Letter of acceptance from the intended educational institution
3. Letter of recommendation from a member of the staff of the High School from which the applicant graduated
4. Other letters of recommendation are optional but are a definite plus.
